## ISIS CENTRAL SUGAR MILL SCHOLARSHIP ASSISSTANCE PROGRAM FUNDING GUIDELINES

#### POLICY OVERVIEW

PCCC Ltd Board recognises that education, specifically higher education, plays a vital role in improving the overall state of our people particularly their health and economic wellbeing and ability to contribute to our community. That, as well as being able to participate effectively in broader society, is the PCCC Constituency.

For PCCC to improve the educational outcome for its members, the PCCC Ltd Board has identified tertiary education as an imperative and in such comes under Priority Three in its suite of programs available to its membership. The PCCC Ltd Education committee has developed this policy as part of the PCCC Education Assistance Range of Programs.

PCCC Ltd and Isis Central Sugar Mill (ICSM) have two scholarships available to PCCC people enrolled in full-time undergraduate academic program at a University in Queensland which would, in the ordinary course, result in those students obtaining a Bachelor Degree in one of the following areas (being areas in which ICSM employs Staff) namely mechanical or chemical engineering, business, law, human resource management or technical instrumentation or other technical skills pertinent to sugar mills and in STEM related areas of Study.

#### **FUNDING AVAILABLE**

Two (2) annual grants of up to \$10,000.00 per person will be made available as scholarships for PCCC members who qualify under this program, and who are, or wish to engage in, undergraduate level studies at University. In addition, ICSM will offer four weeks paid vacation placement to scholarship holders. Applicants need to submit a formal PCCC Ltd application form.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

These tertiary scholarships are available to applicants who meet <u>all</u> the following criteria:

- Aboriginal tertiary students from PCCC native title group i.e. (Taribelang, Byellee, Gooreng Gooreng and Gurang people);
- Enrolled in, or planning to enrol full-time in an undergraduate degree at a University in Queensland in the areas of study in which ICSM employs staff, including STEM related areas of study





#### REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

The following documents must be submitted with the application:

- A written statement of approximately 250 words outlining why you are undertaking studies towards a University Degree
- How the Scholarship could financially support and enhance your studies
- Your personal achievements and career aspirations
- Evidence of your contribution to and / or leadership in community service
- Academic transcripts/proof of enrolment
- Two written references, one being from a recognised PCCC Indigenous community member and another which may be academic, religious, community engagement, professional, or personal in nature.

#### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

Applications are assessed on the strength of the following criteria:

- · Written statement
- Community Service
- Proof of Enrolment
- Written references one community referee and one academic, religious, community engagement, professional, or personal referee.

#### APPLICATION PROCESS

- Applications to be received before 31 January 2022
- Must disclose previous courses enrolled in, and whether these have been completed.
- Must submit a certified copy of academic transcript if already studying; and
- One community referee (from a recognised PCCC Indigenous community member), and another which may be academic, religious, community engagement, professional, or personal in nature.

Please note that scholarship applications of current holders will only be considered if the candidate has successfully progressed under the current scholarship. That is, if you are awarded a scholarship in 2022 you will not be awarded one in 2023 if you have not made satisfactory progress, which means a pass mark in all subjects enrolled in at time of application.

• The Recipients must attain a pass mark or above in each subject of their study prior to receiving a scholarship payment.





#### **SELECTION PROCESS**

- The applications will be assessed by the Scholarship Committee and ISCM, in consultation with the PCCC Ltd Executive, and recommended to the PCCC Ltd and ICSM Boards for approval
- Unsuccessful applicants will be formally advised by letter from PCCC Ltd.

#### **SELECTION COMMITTEE**

The PCCC Trust Board and a nominated official from Isis Central Sugar Mill will form the Scholarship Committee for the evaluation process

**DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS:** 2022 Payment Schedule – PCCC Ltd and Isis Central Sugar Mill Scholarships:

PAYMENT	FULL TIME	NOTES
PAYMENT 1	\$5000.00	Upon successful completion of Semester 1 of the relevant academic year
PAYMENT 2	\$5000.00	Upon Successful Completion of Semester 2 of the relevant academic year

- Payment is dependent on successful completion of Semester One and Two with the initial payment of \$5000.00 to be paid upon successful completion of Semester One
- Approval will be for those who are continuing with University courses within Queensland and new applications for subsequent years
- Progress will be deemed successful when:
  - Scholarships Students have provided certified academic transcripts detailing at least a PASS mark in all subjects enrolled in for the sponsored semester; and
  - A report is tabled with student feedback on the course;
- The Chair of the Scholarship Committee or nominee will submit the names of recommended applicants to PCCC Trust Board and ICSM Board for approval before final approval and payment of Scholarship fees
- A joint PCCC Ltd and ICSM Letter of Offer of Assistance will be provided to confirm the terms of the approval





#### Paid Vacation Placement

ICSM will offer four weeks paid vacation placement to scholarship recipients each year. While ICSM will endeavour to place the scholarship holder in the chosen field of study, this will depend on operational circumstances, and the placement could potentially be in other disciplines. The rate of pay shall be the minimum hourly award payment for the relevant role that the person is employed in.
