ISSUES TO BE DISCUSSED

1. Gladstone Ports Corporation – Amendment of Ancillary Agreement

On 21 November 2013 an Indigenous Land Use Agreement ('ILUA') was entered into between the claimants of the Port Curtis Coral Coast People Native Title Claim and the Gladstone Ports Corporation ('GPC').

Currently 65% of the monies payable by GPC under the ILUA are paid directly to the PCCC Charitable Trust ('the Charitable Trust') to be distributed in accordance with the Charitable Trusts corporate governance framework.

The remaining 35% of the money due and payable, were to be held and distributed in conjunction with GPC. The PBC has requested that these funds are also paid directly into the Trust and managed in line with the other funds.

GPC have agreed to this change as they believe that the funds should be distributed by yourselves under the Charitable Trust corporate governance framework.



Variations such as this can be addressed through amendments to the Ancillary Agreement. The Directors are seeking to obtain the authorisation of the native title holders so that these amendments can be made to the Ancillary Agreement.

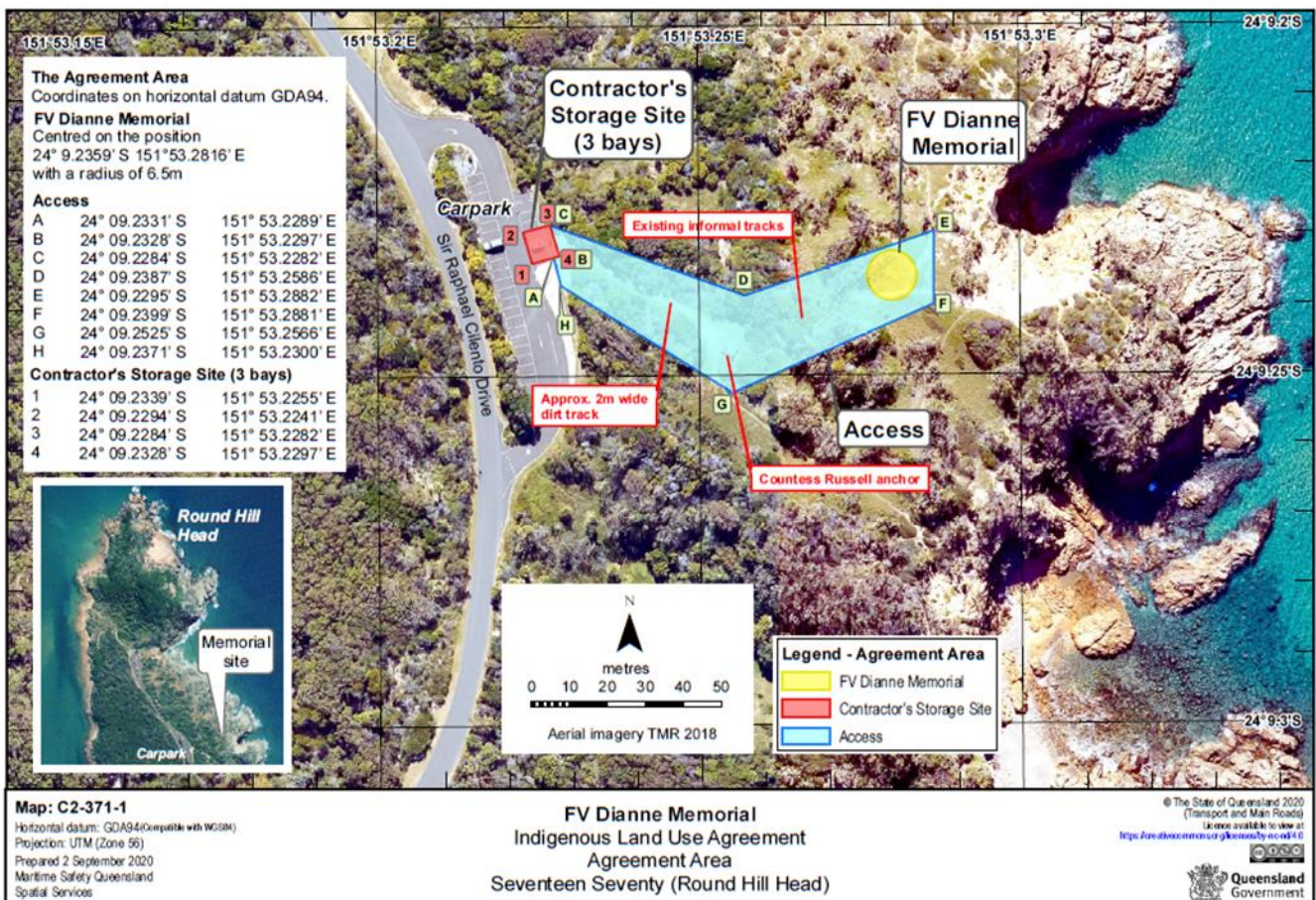
The State's proposed FV Dianne Memorial Indigenous Land Use Agreement

The State of Queensland represented by the Department of Transport and Main Roads (**the State**) wishes to construct the FV Dianne Memorial honouring the victims and survivors of the sinking of the fishing trawler *Dianne* off the coast near the Town of 1770 on 16 October 2017.

To facilitate the State's proposal, the State and the First Nations Bailai, Gurang, Gooreng Gooreng, Taribelang Bunda People Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC (ICN: 8650) (**the Corporation**) are proposing to enter into an Indigenous Land Use Agreement (Body Corporate Agreement) pursuant to Subdivision B of Division 3 of Part 2 of the *Native Title Act 1993* (Cth) (**the ILUA**).

The proposed ILUA Agreement Area

The ILUA "Agreement Area" comprises the "FV Dianne Memorial", "Access" and "Contractor's Storage Site" as shown on the map below. The Agreement Area forms part of the Joseph Banks (Round Hill Head) Conservation Park, which is located wholly within the boundaries of the *First Nations Bailai, Gurang, Gooreng Gooreng, Taribelang Bunda People Native Title Determination* (QCD2017/010; QUD6026/2001) (**the Determination**).



First Nations Bailai, Gurang, Gooreng Gooreng, Taribelang Bunda People Consultation and Consent

In accordance with the requirements of the *Native Title (Prescribed Body Corporate) Regulations 1999* and the Corporation's Rule Book, before entering into the ILUA, the Corporation must consult with and obtain the consent of the First Nations Bailai, Gurang, Gooreng Gooreng, Taribelang Bunda People (**BGGGTB People**).

The BGGGTB People are described in the Determination as the descendants of the following apical ancestors:

Key terms of the proposed ILUA

Under the terms of the proposed ILUA:

1. "FV Dianne Memorial" means the walking path and memorial/lookout to be constructed on the Agreement Area honouring the victims and survivors of the sinking of the trawler Dianne on 16 October 2017, as shown by the circle on the map of Agreement Area centred on the position 24° 9.2359' S 151°53.2816' E with a radius of 6.5 metres.
2. The BGGGTB People consent to the doing of each of the following Agreed Acts:
 - a) the construction, operation, maintenance, use and repair of the FV Dianne Memorial;
 - b) the construction, operation, maintenance, use and repair of the "Contractor's Storage Site";
 - c) the construction, operation, maintenance, use and repair of the "Access"; and
 - d) all "Future Acts" necessary or incidental to the acts in (a) to (c).
3. The parties acknowledge that the Non-Extinguishment Principle applies to the extent that no native title will be extinguished.
