KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

POSITION OVERVIEW:

- 1. Cultural Guidance: Provide cultural guidance, knowledge, and teachings to students, staff, and community members, fostering a deeper understanding and appreciation of First Nations cultures and traditions.
- 2. Elder Mentorship: Serve as a mentor and role model, offering wisdom, support, and guidance to individuals seeking to learn more about First Nations culture and history.
- **3.** Cultural Activities: Facilitate cultural activities, workshops, and events within River Connections such as storytelling, traditional crafts, language lessons, and ceremonies.
- 4. Documentation: Maintain records of cultural activities, resources, and materials, and contribute to the documentation and preservation of First Nations knowledge and heritage.
- **5.** Collaboration: Collaborate with school or River Connections staff, First Nations elders and knowledge holders, community members, and external partners to plan and implement cultural engagement initiatives within River Connections.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- First Nations background and deep knowledge of First Nations cultures, traditions, and protocols, with a strong focus on First Nations history on water ways and their importance.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills, with the ability to engage and connect with diverse audiences.
- Respect for cultural diversity and a commitment to fostering inclusive and respectful environments.
- Experience in mentoring, teaching, or facilitating cultural activities preferred.
- Willingness to undergo relevant checks, including a Blue Card (or equivalent) and a criminal history check.
- Valid driver's license and access to transportation, as travel may be required.
- Flexibility to work casual hours, including evenings and weekends, as needed.
