Our traineeships are supported by formal training and qualifications through a Registered Training Organisation and will provide you with ongoing mentorship to assist you in achieving a long-term career within your chosen field.

If successful in a traineeship with UnitingCare Queensland you will be supported in a culturally safe environment with mentors who will guide you in your traineeship journey.

What we are looking for?

You will have a genuine interest and passion for Human, Health or Community services while also having a desire to pursue a qualification in Business Administration, Community Services, Customer Service, Health Services, Warehousing, Food Services or Individual Support. Supplementing the above you will be enthusiastic, have a strong work ethic with the ability to commit to the entire period of the traineeship along with demonstrated integrity and respect for your community.

Eligibility:

School Based:

To be eligible for a school based opportunity you will need to be commencing Year 11 or 12 in 2019. You will need to meet the entry level requirements for a vocational education and training (VET) qualification at a Certificate level III.

(If you are due to finish year 12 at the end of 2018 you may be eligible for one of our Full time/Part Time Traineeships)

Full Time / Part Time Adult Traineeships

To be eligible for a full time or part time Adult traineeship you will need to meet the entry level requirements for a vocational education and training (VET) qualification at a Certificate level III
