RE: Gooreng Gooreng Director PBC Director Vacancy

We are writing to let you know that we are seeking nominations for the position of Gooreng Gooreng Director on the First Nations Bailai, Gurang, Gooreng Gooreng, Taribelang Bunda Prescribed Body Corporate (PBC). The appointment will be for 3 years or less dependant upon GGAFAC requirements. The Nominee is required to sign a declaration of agreement to act on behalf of the GGAFAC and all of the Gooreng Gooreng Apical Families.

You would be aware that following our Consent Determination in 2017, we were required by law to establish a PBC to manage our native title and cultural heritage interests. The Prescribed Body Corporate (PBC) was set up in 2018 with representatives from each of the Traditional Owner Groups: 2 Gooreng Gooreng, 2 Taribelang Bunda, 2 Gurang and 2 Bailai.

This Board is not to be confused with the PCCC Trust Board who is responsible for the management of our assets and the social programs such as Back to School, Tertiary scholarships, Elders program and White Goods program. Neville Johnson and Nereda Dawn White are our elected Directors on that Board.

Our original Directors on the PBC were Nat Minniecon and Marilyn Smith who have served our people well. We thank them for their service and wish them all the best for their futures. Nereda Dawn White is one of our current Gooreng Gooreng Directors on the PBC, a requirement being that of each of the 4 groups, one Director must be on both the PBC and PCCC Boards. That leaves one position for us to fill on the PBC.



As a Director, you will be required to attend meetings several times a year and any extraordinary meetings that come up. Board meetings are held in Bundaberg, Gladstone, and Brisbane or by Zoom. Your travel costs will be covered.

SELECTION PROCESS

To select the new Director, we will undertake the following process.

1. Request for Nominations will be sent out via email and other mediums e.g Facebook.
2. A Gooreng Gooreng Board Selection Committee will be set up through the Gooreng Gooreng Apical Families Corporation (GGAFC).
3. The Gooreng Gooreng Board Selection Committee will meet to consider written applications and to select the most suitable applicant.
4. The Gooreng Gooreng Board Selection Committee will inform the Chair of the PBC of our preferred Director.
5. PBC will confirm the Gooreng Gooreng Director Appointment.

REQUEST FOR NOMINATIONS

If you are interested in becoming a PBC Director, you must belong to one or more of the 13 Apical families under the Gooreng Gooreng Nation and you will need to do the following:

1. Complete the Directors Nomination Form as attached; Please ask another Gooreng Gooreng person, preferably an Elder to be your Nominator
2. Supply a current Resume/CV with your qualifications, employment history, skills and experience.
3. Provide a Cover Letter (minimum of 200 words) sharing why you believe you will be the best Gooreng Gooreng Director representative.

Nomination for Directors must be made in writing by post or email by **COB Friday 28 August, 2020.**
