Port Curtis Coral Coast Trust Limited (PCCC) represents the Byellee, Gooreng Gooreng, Gurang and Taribelang Bunda people who make up the Port Curtis Coral Coast Native Title claim group. The PCCC native title claim area covers land of approximately 19,583 kilometres and a sea area of approximately 26,386 kilometres in South Queensland from the Gladstone area south to the Bundaberg region.

The PCCC has many Native Title priorities and the community is looking forward to Consent Determination being handed down in November 2017. This is a historical moment for the claim and community to finally get recognition after such a long fight.

The Trust is also responsible for running a number of socio programs to provide empowering assistance to our community including:

 - The PCCC Trust White Goods Program is designed to provide assistance to PCCC families with the supply of essential household Whitegoods.
