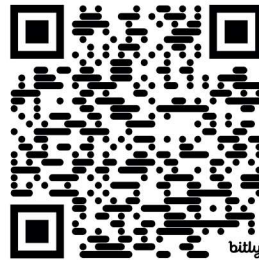


Join our Deadly Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Cadetship Program

Queensland Health is offering First Nations Cadetship positions across Nursing, Midwifery, Allied Health, and Corporate Services streams in 2025.



A cadet is employed as a temporary part time employee in their chosen profession, gaining on the job skill development while completing their full-time tertiary studies for a bachelors qualification in Australia.

Cadets work under the delegation and supervision of a line manager and clinical supervisor in their field to provide effective patient care. It is required the Cadet completes 12 weeks (or 60 days) of paid-work over the calendar year.

Clinical Cadetship positions will be available in Nursing and Midwifery, Physiotherapy, Social Work, Speech Pathology, Occupational Therapy, Nutrition and Dietetics, Exercise Physiology, Medical Imaging/Radiation Therapy, Podiatry, Medical Laboratory Science, Audiology, Biomedical Science, Pharmacy, Psychology and Sonography.

Corporate Services Cadetship positions will be available but not limited to Law, Information Technology, Marketing and Communications, Finance, Public Health and Human Resources, Accounting, Business and Policy.

The hours worked by the cadet are scheduled to fit around study commitments during the calendar year. Students can apply for a cadetship at any year of their university course and continue the program through to graduation.

There is also the option, if all eligibility criteria is met, for Cadets to receive a study allowance of \$13,000 through our Government Partner AFL Sports Ready.

Under S125 of the Anti-Discrimination Act 1991, there is a genuine occupation requirement for the incumbent to be Indigenous to the Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander Community to be eligible for a Cadetship under this program.
