2026 WHITEGOODS TERMS AND CONDITIONS

OBJECTIVE:

- The intent of the “White Goods Assistance Program” is to assist First Nation Bailai, Gurang, Gooreng Gooreng, and Taribelang Bunda (FNBGGGTB) families by providing essential household white goods.
- You must agree to the Terms and Conditions this application to be forwarded to the FNBGGGTB Board of Directors for consideration. Your signature is to be recorded in the declaration on page 3 of this application.

FUNDING AVAILABLE:

- First Nations Bailai, Gurang, Gooreng Gooreng, and Taribelang Bunda individuals who have received White Goods under the program in the previous two (2) years are NOT ELIGIBLE for the 2026 round of the program.
- No direct cash payment will be made to applicants.
- White Goods such as Fridges, Freezers, Washing Machines, Air Conditioners, to the amount of **\$750.00** will be distributed to a maximum of forty (40) families in the 2026 round of the FNBGGGTB White Goods Assistance Program.
- The White Goods Assistance Program is designed for FNBGGGTB families who are in greatest financial need, determined by the information provided to support the applications (as outlines in the checklist on page 2 of this application).

NEW APPLICANTS:

- If you have not applied before, you must provide a family tree to help FNBGGGTB staff verify your connection to one of the four eligible tribal groups.

SUPPLIERS:

- You will be given a choice of two stores, which are The Good Guys and Harvey Norman.

PROOF OF RESIDENCE/ADDRESS:

- First Nations Bailai, Gurang, Gooreng Gooreng, and Taribelang Bunda individuals wishing to access this assistance must provide an electricity bill or other household utility, or rates notice which matches the address on the application form.

PROOF OF INCOME

- First Nations Bailai, Gurang, Gooreng Gooreng, and Taribelang Bunda individuals wishing to access this assistance must Centrelink confirmation of status by Centrelink (e.g. Benefits received, Newstart, Single Parent, Low Income or Pay Slip).

SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS:

- FNBGGGTB will provide a White Goods Acceptance Agreement that confirms the FNBGGGTB Board’s decision and includes details about the store you will need to choose from. A copy of the policy will also be included with this letter.

UNSUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS:

- A letter will be sent confirming the Board decision and explain why the application was not successful.
