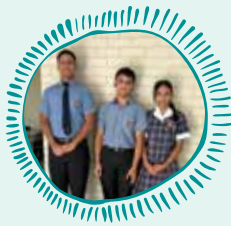

Priority 1

Back to School Assistance Education program

Investing in our youth from day one. This program backs our FNBGGGTB families and carers with children from Prep to Grade 12 by easing the financial pressure of school fees, uniforms, and essential materials. Every year, we ensure dozens of students hit the classroom with the resources and confidence they need for a successful year of learning.



Priority 2

Enhancement, Political, Social, Cultural Engagement and Sporting Assistance program

Fuelling the passions and talents of our people. Designed for FNBGGGTB peoples enrolled full-time in study or actively participating in political, social, cultural, or sporting arenas, this initiative opens doors to next-level opportunities. Each academic year, we proudly deliver thirty (30) grants of up to \$3,000 per student to back your journey!



Priority 3

Tertiary Education Scholarship program

Supporting our future leaders as they break new ground. This scholarship supports FNBGGGTB students pursuing Cert IV, Diploma, undergraduate, postgraduate, and Higher Degree Research studies at Australian institutes or universities. Each year, we award twenty-four (24) grants of up to \$5,000 to empower our people engaged in advanced academic pathways.



White Goods Assistance Program

Bringing comfort and convenience straight to your home. Age Pension Assistance Program

Caring for our Elders who have paved the way for us. This program delivers dedicated assistance to help our FNBGGGTB Elders navigate their pension pathways with ease, including a \$300 annual payment to assist with essential living costs. We ensure they have access to the resources, support, and care they deserve to enjoy their retirement comfortably on Country.

By offering unique, hands-on opportunities, the program inspires young people to stay deeply engaged in their education and maintain strong school attendance through to the end of Grade 12.

Students from Bundaberg, Gladstone, North Burnett, and Woorabinda come together to participate in traditional canoe building alongside skilled craftsmen, Elders, and school representatives.

Alongside mastering water safety, navigation, and boat-building techniques, participants engage in practical health and nutrition education while strengthening their multimedia, literacy, and numeracy skills.

Students also get the exciting opportunity to showcase their hard work at regional regattas and community events. This powerful initiative fosters deep teamwork, regional connection, and personal growth, empowering our young people to build lifelong skills and friendships while proudly celebrating their shared cultural and environmental heritage.

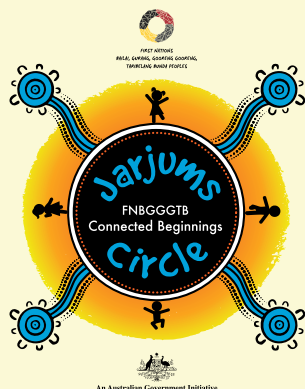
